Artistic Education

He starts modern dance studies at the School of Teatro Nuovo of Turin, managed by Carla Perotti, continuing at a later time to take courses without attending particular schools, despite that he cultivates his passion with the profession of bartender in rotation, finding himself to start his carrier as professional at a mature age for dance. He meets few, but very important figures of the Italian scene and more, with whom he had the fortune to deepen his study and he worked with some of them too: Anna Sagna, Raffaella Giordano, Giorgio Rossi, Roberto Castello. He attended study cycles of sensitive dance by Claude Coldy, body language with Doriana Crema. Around the actorial field he meets: Danio Manfredini, Enrique Pardo, Philippe Hottier and Pierre Byland.

He's the main actor of Giacono eroe quotidiano e Fiumana, a many times awarded short movie, such as - Visioni Italiane 2003 (Bologna) Visioni ambientali Award - Valsusa Filmfest 2004- Mario Celso Special Award. A bit later they work together again to the production of Dalla parte di Swan, reaching the second place and receiving a Mention for the dramaturgy and the narrative cohesion - at LA DANZA IN 1 MINUTO Contest, BEYON ONE MINUTE SECTION - SWANS NEVER DIE, project by Coorpi and the artistic direction of Lucia Carolina De Renzo and Enrico Coffetti, This section, created inside the project SWANS NEVER DIE was focused on Italian artists or active in Italy, whom by a screen dance re-enactment process had to work on new contemporary interpretations of the famous choreography "Swan's Death" by Michel Fokine for Anna Pavlova, on the music by Camille Saint Saens.

Dalla Parte di Swan is somehow the anticipation of the solo SWAN.

also in 2022 at 20° MonFilmFest they took part to Giochi di Cinema Senza Frontiere in Valcerrina receiving the second Prize SETTE GIORNI PER UN FILM OFF SITE with "TRA" by Sandro Carnino. The motivation was: It seduces mainly for the originality shown in addressing the theme of diversity and marginalization with a hint of irony and a melancholy aftertaste, enhanced by the exceptional performance of actor Aldo Rendina. At last a Special Mention from the Direction of the Festival to Aldo Rendina: for the complexity of the interpretations at MonFilmfest, achieved with TRA's.
